

Second Floor

The arrangement of the second floor of the new building is largely repeated from the first floor below.

The main difference at this level is the inclusion of the suite of learning and teaching facilities for Executive Education, which is located in the southern wing of the building.

A shared staff common room is also provided on the second floor within the 'knuckle' the coming together of the two academic departments ranged in wings to either side that will engender collaboration and the academic exchange of ideas.

Third Floor

The third floor of the building accommodates the bar/reception and dining spaces associated with the learning and teaching facilities for Executive Education on the floor below.

This top floor function space is articulated as a central pavilion on the roof and is set back from the three storey symmetrical façade below to break up the silhouette of the building against the sky when seen from outside the site boundary and help the new building sit comfortably amongst the varied St Andrews roofscape when seen from the hills to the south.


Solar photovoltaic panels are incorporated on the remaining areas of flat roof and these are screened by the surrounding parapet walls.




Concept view showing dining room interior on third floor
